

Traditionally a symbol of independence, the American flag has carried the message of freedom to numerous areas of the world. In the Usa, the flag is shown daily in o-r near government buildings and schools and in many public areas. It's customary to fly the flag on Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Labor Day and other U.S. holidays. All the flag's colors has a significance: Red indicates hardiness and valor; white is symbolic of purity and innocence; and blue denotes caution, perseverance and justice. Just as the flag's colors and style are deeply symbolic, therefore is the way the flag is displayed. Here are a few flag etiquette tips from AmericanFlags.com: * When the flag is shown over the heart of the street, it must be suspended vertically with the nation (stars) to the north in an street or to the east in a street. When displayed in a window it must be displayed in the same way, with the union to the left of the observer in the road. * To fold the flag, first fold it by 50 percent over the stripes twice.
