

The Disney Company's first Alice Comedy.. Wally Disney's signature contracting him for the Alice Comedies on October 16th 1923 was the foundation of the "Disney Company"; previously referred to as Disney Brothers Cartoon Studio. Wally had made a decision to use up an offer from his brother Roy Oliver Disney to join him in Hollywood from Kansas City. Walt brought with him his last one-reeler named "Alice in Wonderland"; which combined live action with animation kick starting the Alice Comedies. The Disney Company's first Alice Comedy called Alices Day at Sea was produced in 1924 before at the tip of Roy, the Disney Company was renamed Walt Disney Studio in 1926. The Alice line ended in 1927 giving way for the initial cartoon "Oswald the Lucky Rabbit." Next Mortimer Mouse produced by Disney and Iwerks failed to locate a provider, nevertheless with prompting from Lillie Belle it had been chosen to throw Mortimer in the first sound lively film Steamboat Willie. With approximately budgets of \$1.5 million Snow White held worldwide followers and became the highest grossing movie until Gone with the Wind in 1939. The success of the film allowed Disney to build a new university for Walt Disney Studios in Burbank, which opened for business on Christmas Eve, 1939. His team, by this time had swelled to a lot more than one thousand artists, writers, artists, and specialists. The Walt Disney Studio had basically grown up. Walt Disney Studios had just finished Pinocchio and were taking care of Bambi and Fantasia when World War II broke out in 1939. Neither performed particularly well, while Pinocchio and Fantasia were both released. Following the US entered the war, ninetyfour % of Disney's studio facilities were bought out by the army for work with training films for the armed services, health films for most people, and small propaganda items like Der Fuhrer's Face. The cheaply produced Dumbo made some money for the studio, but Bambi finally released in 1942, also bombed on its initial release. For the next many years, the facility focused on compilation films and pants. It was not until the late forties that they had recovered enough to start out concentrating on feature films again.
